

THIS WEEK'S TOPIC:

Kam jsi šel/šla?/

Where did you go?

PAST TENSE - regular

JET, JEZDIT, CHODIT



- já jsem jel
- ty jsi jel
- on jel



- já jsem jela
- ty jsi jela
- ona jela



ono jelo

- (= I went - using means of transport eg. by car)
- (= you went - using means of transport eg. by car)
- (= he/she/it went - - using means of transport eg. by car)

- my jsme jeli
- vy jste jeli
- oni jeli

- (= we went - using means of transport eg. by car)
- (= you went - using means of transport eg. by car) - as a group
- (= they went - using means of transport eg. by car)

The same system is used for all regular verbs:

I went (means of transport, repetitive action, masculine) - jezdil jsem

they walked (repetitive action) - chodili

Examples:

Ráno **jsem nešla** do supermarketu. **Jela jsem** na policii .

= I didn't go (on foot) to the supermarket this morning. I went to the police station. (female)

Kam **jsi** minulý měsíc tak často **jezdil** ? - **Jezdil jsem** na univerzitu do Prahy.

= Where did you go so often last month? - I went to university in Prague.

Jana **chodila** každé ráno na zastávku.

= Jana went to the bus stop every morning.

Jezdili jsme na letiště vždy/vždycky* metrem a autobusem. Včera **jsme** ale **jeli** taxíkem*.

= We always took the underground and bus to the airport. But yesterday we took a taxi.

Chodili jste minulý týden na oběd do restaurace?

= Did you go to a restaurant for lunch last week?

Nejeli včera do Prahy na koncert, protože měli hodně práce.

= They didn't go to Prague yesterday for the concert because they had a lot of work to do.
